



In **ROSARIUM VIRGINIS MARIAE**, our St. Pope John Paul II 's Apostolic Letter, he encourages greater devotion and deeper contemplation on each of the mysteries of the Rosary. He recognized the Rosary as "*the sweet chain linking us to God*" which would grant abundant graces and Mary's special maternal love and protection on all those who prayed it faithfully.

St. Louis de Montfort called the Rosary "*a priceless treasure inspired by God*" and assured those who prayed it daily would "*never be led astray by the devil*" for Satan feared the Mother of God just as much as he feared God Himself.

From our blessed Mother, St. Dominic received this advice on how to shepherd his parishioners: ".... *Before doing anything, priests should try to kindle a love for* 

prayer . . . especially a love for my Rosary. . .so preach my Rosary...". Mary added that if priests would start saying it and persevere, "God in His mercy could hardly refuse to give them His grace . . . ".

Shortly after her death, St. Teresa of Avila appeared to one of her sisters saying she was "willing to return to a life of suffering . . . to merit the degree of glory that God rewards to those devoutly reciting the Rosary. . .".

We certainly cannot afford to turn our backs to such tremendous graces and divine assurances of salvation . Let's all start today to give Jesus and our Mother Mary fifteen minutes daily to pray the Rosary and never live to say: *IF ONLY WE HAD LISTENED*!!
