



A Message From Pope Francis

At his Sunday, Oct. 6 Angelus address, delivered just after the opening of the Synod of Bishops, Pope Francis called upon families to read the Bible.

"For the family to be able to proceed well, with trust and hope, it must be nurtured by the Word of God," he said. As Bibles were distributed to those in attendance, Pope Francis said, "Today as the Synod for the Family opens, with the help of the Pauline Brothers, there is a Bible for every family. Not just to put on a shelf, but to keep it on hand, dip into it often, both individually and together, husband and wife, parents and children, perhaps in the evening, especially on Sundays. In this way, the family will grow and walk in the light and the strength of God's Word."

Our Lady of the Mountains Fall Festival is drawing near. Our festival committee has been planning and coordinating over the past few months to provide a great community fund raiser for our church.


We need everyone's help to make this festival a success so outside of mass today you will find multiple sign-up sheets for everything
