

All Soul's Day

All soul's day was started in 998. It's a Roman Catholic day of remembrance for friends and loved ones who have passed away. All Souls's Day is on November 2, following All Saint's Day unless this is a Sunday.

November 2 is the day on which special prayers are offered for the souls of the faithful which at death have not been cleansed from venial sins, or have not atoned for past transgressions. It is a time to pray for their souls to assist the souls from Purgatory to Heaven.
