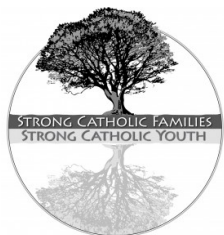

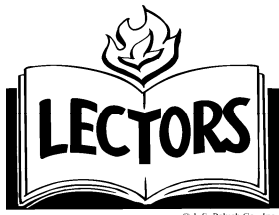

DATES TO REMEMBER

Sunday, November 30 No classes, Thanksgiving holiday

When Jesus was asked to name the greatest of the commandments, he summed up the ten commandments in two: love of God and love of neighbor. Jesus was making an intimate link of how our love of neighbor is a reflection of how we love God. We cannot separate the two.

In the time of the desert monks there was an abbot by the name of Moses who was well known for his holiness of life. One year as Easter was approaching the monks met to discuss how they should prepare for it. They agreed to a complete fast for all of Holy Week. With the decision being made, each monk went to his cell to fast and pray.

During the middle of the week, two monks came to visit the cell of Abbot Moses. Seeing that they were very hungry, he cooked a little vegetable stew for them. To make them feel at ease he took a little of it himself.

The other monks had seen the smoke rising from the abbot's cell. It could mean only one thing; he had lit a fire to cook some food. In other words, he had broken the solemn fast. They were shocked, and in the eyes of many, he fell from his pinnacle of sanctity. The monks went to confront their abbot.

Seeing the judgment in their eyes, he asked, "*What crime have I committed that makes you look at me like this?*" "*You have broken the solemn fast,*" they answered.

"*So I have,*" he replied. "*I have broken the commandment of people, but in sharing my food with these brothers of ours, I have kept the commandment of God that we should love one another.*"

On hearing this, the monks grew silent, and went away humbled but wiser!

So often people will use the rules and regulations as a means to avoid having to love one's neighbor, in other words, to avoid getting involved. The life of a Christian demands that we roll up our sleeves and get involved in the messiness of life. To put on the jersey with the big "C" on the front and stand on the sidelines and watch the game, is not enough.

Faith is a call to action. Christ showed us how to live the Gospel in its totality, that is, how to love God and to love our neighbor as well. Jesus didn't say they were the same thing, but that we cannot have one without the other.

May the words of Abbot Moses both humble and inspire us as well.
