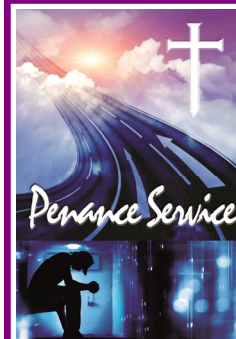

BREAKFAST WITH SANTA

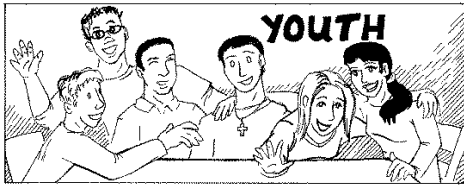
