

#### **True Face**

The word "veronica" is the name given to the veil that tradition says was used to wipe the face of Jesus on his way of the cross. It is probably second only to the Holy Shroud among the "Volto Santo" (Holy Face) relics. "Veronica" is really the two Latin words, vera and icon, "true image", referring to the Sacred Face. Some say it was the centurion's wife, Seraphica, who did this work of mercy, and later discovered his face on the cloth. Other legends say the woman was Martha, and still others, Zacchaeus' wife, or the woman Christ healed of an issue of blood (Mk 5:25-32). No mention of an actual person named "Veronica" can be found earlier than the fifth century.(Catholic Source Book)





### CARDIOVASCULAR ULTRASOUND SCREENINGS

#### **HEART ULTRASOUND**

Screening visualizes the heart valves, measures systolic function, the motility of the left ventricle, ejection fraction and dimensions of the atrium and ventricles.

#### ATRIAL FIBRILLATION

Atrial fibrillation is a heart rhythm problem found in almost one in every 150 people causing palpitations, shortness of breath, fatigue and risk of stroke.

#### **CAROTID ARTERY**

Stroke is the most common cause of long term care admissions in the US. This screening will show your level of plaque build up in the carotid arteries.

#### **THYROID**

Screening detects cysts, nodules and other abnormalities that may indicate signs of thyroid disease.

#### PERIPHERAL ARTERIAL DISEASE (PAD)

Peripheral arterial disease (PAD) is a condition where blood circulation is restricted. It affects over 8 million Americans. This screening detects signs of circulatory problems in the lower extremities.

## ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND SCREENINGS

#### ABDOMINAL AORTIC ANEURYSM

Aneurysms form as a result of weakening in the arterial wall. This ultrasound screening detects aneurysms and other abnormalities.

#### LIVER

Scans for cysts, nodules, masses, and texture/density/size changes of the liver.

#### **KIDNEY**

Scans for cysts, nodules, masses, stones, fluid and more.

#### **GALLBLADDER**

Scans for stones, sludge, wall thickening and other abnormalities.

#### **PANCREAS**

The pancreas is an important organ providing essential hormones and digestive enzymes.

This screening detects small lesions, abnormalities and other signs of disease.

The spleen is essential in regard to red blood cells and the immune system. This screening detects an enlarged spleen and additional signs of disease.
