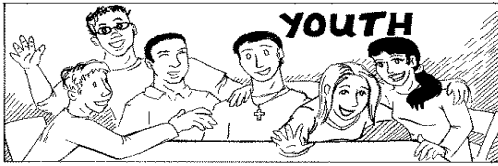

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL REGISTRATION

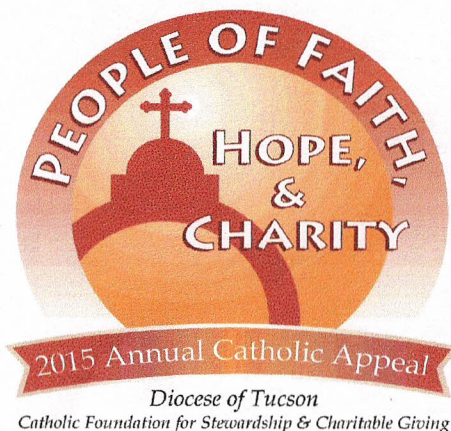
