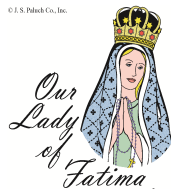

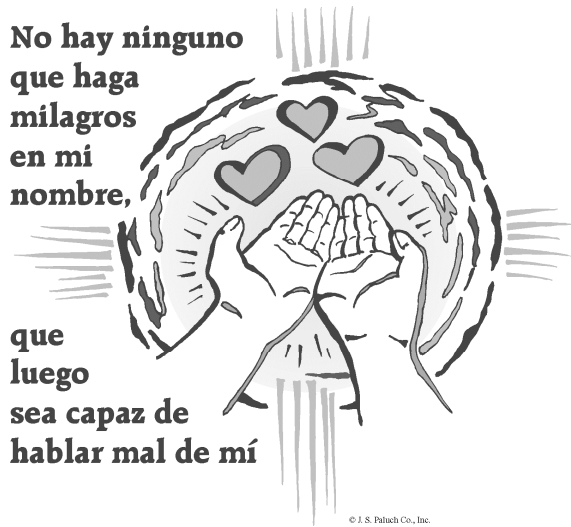

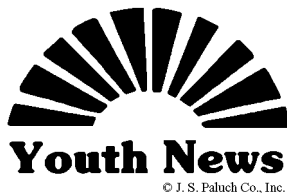


All Saints Catholic School News

September 27, Feast of St. Vincent de Paul

St. Vincent de Paul was a priest who lived in France from 1580-1660. A deathbed confession of a servant opened Vincent's eyes to the great spiritual needs of the peasantry of France. This seems to have been an epiphany moment for Vincent. The Countess de Gondi, whose servant Vincent had helped, persuaded her husband to endow and support a group of able and zealous missionaries who would work among poor tenant farmers and country people. At first Vincent was too humble to accept leadership, but after working for a while in Paris among imprisoned galley slaves, he returned to lead what is now known as the Congregation of the Mission, or the Vincentians. These priests, with vows of poverty, chastity, obedience, and stability, were to devote themselves entirely to people in smaller towns and villages.

Later, Vincent established confraternities of charity for the spiritual and physical relief of the poor and sick of each parish. From these with the help of St. Louise de Marillac came the Daughters of Charity. He organized the rich women of Paris to collect funds for his missionary projects, founded several hospitals, collected relief funds for the victims of war and ransomed over twelve hundred galley slaves from North Africa.

Pope Leo XIII made him the patron of all charitable societies. Notable among these, of course, is the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, founded in 1833 by his admirer Blessed Frederic Ozanam.
