DATES TO REMEMBER

Sunday, November 29 No classes, Thanksgiving holiday Monday, November 30 Grade 9 Class will be held 6:30p.m.

Advent is the expectation of the Christ and is one of anticipation, reflection and hope as we wait for the arrival of Jesus. The word "advent" comes from the Latin word "Adventus" which means arrival or coming. It is four weeks long, or slightly less, the first two focusing on Jesus final coming as Lord and Judge. The final eight days anticipate his coming in history (Christmas). Since the 10th century, the first Sunday of Advent has marked the beginning of the (Western) church year.

A Jesse Tree is a symbol for Advent. The story of the Jesse Tree or its inspiration comes from Isaiah's prophecy, "There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse." (Is. 11.1) Jesse is King David's father and, so, an ancestor in Jesus' family line (the house of David). Tradition has taken Isaiah's suggestion of Jesus' "family tree", decorating it with ornaments or pictures representing various ancestors like Noah, Jacob, Moses, Ruth, Jesse himself, and David. One new figure is hung each day of Advent. Jesus' spiritual heritage is thus illustrated, and celebrated.

Be with us, Lord, as we enter this waiting season of Advent. We thank you for the many blessings in our lives and with anticipation, preparation and hope we look forward to the arrival of your Son, Jesus, the light of the world. Amen.
