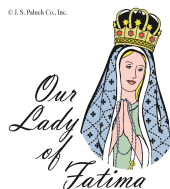

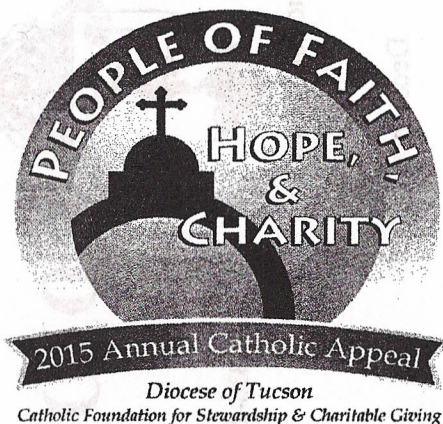
**Tuesday, December 8**, Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Holy Day of Obligation (Opportunity)

A feast called the Conception of Mary arose in the Eastern Church in the seventh century. It came to the West in the eighth century. In the eleventh century it received its present name, The Immaculate Conception. In the eighteenth century it became a feast of the universal church.

In 1854 Pius IX solemnly proclaimed: "The most Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin."

It took a long time for this doctrine to develop. While many fathers and doctors of the church considered Mary the greatest and holiest of the saints, they often had difficulty seeing Mary as sinless; either at her conception or throughout her life. This is one of the church teachings that arose more from the piety of the faithful than from the insights of brilliant theologians. Two Franciscans, William of Ware and Blessed John Duns Scotus, helped develop the theology. They point out that Mary's Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus' redemptive work. Other members of the human race are cleansed from original sin after birth. In Mary, Jesus' work was so powerful as to prevent original sin at the outset.

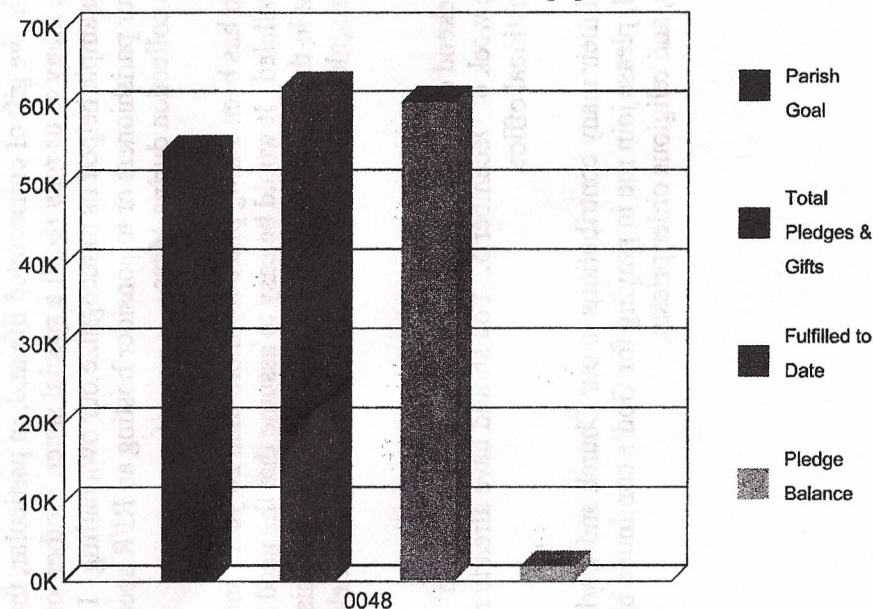




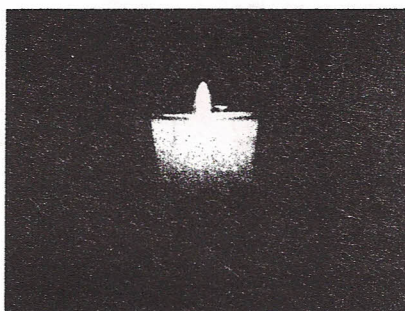

TO ALL PASTORS AND PARISH ADMINISTRATORS OF THE DIOCESE OF TUCSON:

Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ,

In April I sent you a letter announcing that this one year, in December of 2015, the annual collection for the Diocesan Priests' Retirement Fund would be replaced by a collection for the Retirement Fund for Men and Women Religious. This decision was made in support of the Year of Consecrated Religious as promoted by Pope Francis.

As the Year for Consecrated Life draws to a close, the Retirement Fund for Religious (RFR) appeal offers an opportunity to highlight the gift of consecrated life and, in particular, the faithful service of our senior religious. Indeed, many of us may recall a special sister, brother, or religious order priest whose love and example helped us to recognize our own calling. I invite you to share these experiences with your parishioners or to consider hosting an RFR speaker. Most importantly, please announce the collection during Mass.

As you likely know, the RFR collection has been taking place for more than 20 years and the generosity of Catholics has been unparalleled. It would be easy to assume that the need has diminished but it has not. The decrease in the number of religious in compensated ministry and the ever-rising cost of care make it a struggle for religious communities to provide for elder members.

The dates for this collection are the weekend of December 12-13, 2015. The collection envelopes will arrive in your parish the week of December 5. You should have already received the promotional packet from the RFR national office.

In thanksgiving for senior religious and their many contributions to our Church and world, I ask for your heartfelt assistance. Above all, please join me in praying for God's continued blessing on our nation's elderly sisters, brothers, and religious order priests.
