





January 3 is the Feast of the Most Holy Name of Jesus. This devotion became popular because of 12th century monks and nuns but especially through the preaching of St. Bernardine of Siena, a fifteenth century Franciscan. Bernardine used devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus as a way of overcoming bitter and sometimes bloody class struggles and family vendettas in Italian city-states. The devotion grew partly because of Franciscan and Dominican preachers. It spread even more widely after the Jesuits started promoting it in the sixteenth century. In 1721, Pope Innocent XIII extended the feast to the entire church.


