## CARDIOVASCULAR SCREENINGS

### HEART ULTRASOUND

### ATRIAL FIBRILLATION

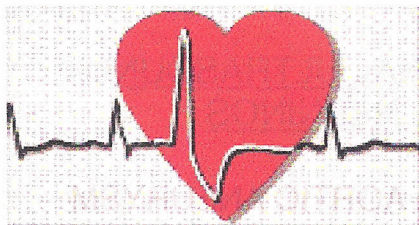
