Thursday we celebrate the feast of St. Patrick. There are many legends surrounding St. Patrick but it may be better to concentrate on who Patrick really was. He had two very solid qualities. He was humble and he was courageous. He accepted suffering and success with equal indifference and thus was able to win most of Ireland for Christ.

The details of his life are largely uncertain. He may have been born in Dunbarton, Scotland, Cumberland, England or northern Wales. He called himself a Briton and a Roman. At 16 he was captured by Irish raiders and sold as a slave. He was forced to work as a shepherd and suffered greatly from cold and hunger. After six years he was able to escape and returned to Briton at the age of 22.

His captivity had led to spiritual conversion. He spent years at Auxerre, France and was consecrated a Bishop at the age of 43. His great desire was to proclaim the Good News to the Irish. Despite opposition from some who felt his education had been defective, he was sent to Ireland to carry out this task. He went to the west and the north where the faith had never been preached, obtained the protection of local kings and made numerous converts. Patrick ordained many priests, divided the country into dioceses, founded several monasteries and continually urged people to greater holiness in Christ.

FAQ

What do I need to do to register my child? Download the application from our website or come to the office. We will also need a copy of their birth certificate and immunizations, as well as copies of any sacraments they have received.

Is there a registration fee? The fee is \$70 if you register your child before May 20th, 2016. It is also important to register before May 20th because this is the date that the CTSO application is due. After May 20th the registration fee is \$90.

What happens if I miss the May 20th CTSO deadline? If you miss the CTSO application deadline, you can apply for financial aid during Round 2 (usually late September). You would be responsible for the full amount of tuition for August, September, and October.

We aren't Catholic. Can my child attend ASCS? Yes! We accept students of all faiths. They will receive a well-rounded academic, faith-based education that will allow them to grow both spiritually and academically. The ASCS student body is currently 85% Catholic and 15% non-Catholic.


