



Jesus was a radical. Consider: "you have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." (Matthew 5:43-44)

This was radical teaching 2,000 years ago. What was the teaching before this? An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth. (Exodus21:24, Leviticus 24:20, Deuteronomy 19:21).

Jesus came along and with one sentence on some dusty road or in a crowded synagogue wiped away the justification of revenge, and the moral, ethical and spiritual development of humanity took a right turn.

This teaching is still radical 2,000 years later. When was the last time you went out of your way to love someone who despises you, opposes you, or makes your life difficult? (Matthew Kelly)






