La visita del papa Francisco a los Estados Unidos el año pasado fue un momento histórico en la vida de la Iglesia Católica en los Estados Unidos. Los obispos católicos en los Estados Unidos quisieron asegurarse que toda persona se uniera al entusiasmo despertado por su visita y le solicitaron a la Campaña Católica de la Comunicación (CCC) que hiciera esto posible.

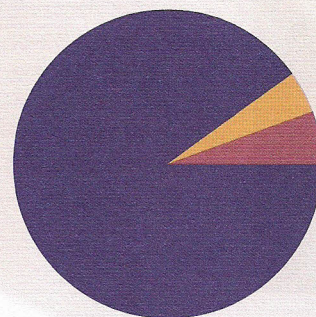
Esto significa que a los millones de personas que no pudieron viajar a las ciudades que visitó el papa, les fue posible participar en tiempo real.
