Today is the feast of St. Romauld (950? - 1027)

After living a wasted life as a youth, Romuald saw his father kill a relative in a duel. Horrified he fled to a monastery in Ravenna, Italy. After 3 years some monks found him to be uncomfortably holy and they eased him out. Romuald spent the next 30 years going about Italy founding monasteries and hermitages. The most famous monastery he founded was that of the Camaldoli in Tuscany. Here he founded the order of the Camaldolese Benedictines. His father later also became a monk and when he wavered was kept faithful through the encouragement of his son.

Christ is a gentle leader, but he calls us all to holiness.Now and then some men and women are raised up to challenge us by the vigor of their spirit and the depth of their conversion. The fact that we cannot duplicate their lives does not change the call to us to be totally open to God in our own particular circumstances.
