

If this is not convenient for you let me know and I will make other arrangements.

There is no charge for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd this year which meets during the 9:30 Mass. Children age 3 (pottytrained only) through Kindergarten are eligible to attend. The best of both worlds... Mom and Dad can pray in peace and the children can begin to know Jesus in a safe and loving environment.
