

After teaching Math for one year I joined the Army and spent the next 20 years working in different countries and different states. After retiring from the military, I worked for the courts at the Juvenile Detention Center as a teacher's aide and teacher. In 1999, I joined the Sierra Vista Unified School District. At SVPS I worked as a teacher, Teacher on Special Assignment, Assistant Principal and Exceptional Student Services Director. I retired on June 30th of this year and started working here at All Saints on July 1. My hobbies are reading, crocheting, and crafts. I am excited to be the new Principal here and with everyone's assistance we are going to have a great school year.

I want to thank those of you who came to religious education registration this past Sunday morning or Monday evening. We have 17 students registered for the coming school year. August 14 is the first day of classes so it is necessary to take an inventory of existing supplies and place an order for textbooks to assure we have materials available on day one. Also, the catechists are beginning their preparations and are in need of their class rosters. So again a big "thank you" to those of you who took time from your busy schedules to attend registration.

The number of registered students is still only about one-third of last year's total registered. We have a somewhat fluid population in the parish and some students who were registered were no longer attending by the end of the year. Also, some students had very sporadic attendance. If there are students who still wish to register for classes please see me as soon as possible. I am in the office from 9:30 -2:30 Monday-Thursday. If this is not convenient for you let me know and I will make other arrangements.

There is no charge for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd this year which meets during the 9:30 Mass. Children age 3 (potty-trained only) through Kindergarten are eligible to attend. The best of both worlds... Mom and Dad can pray in peace and the children can begin to know Jesus in a safe and loving environment.

Again, my thanks and see me soon if you wish to join us this year.


