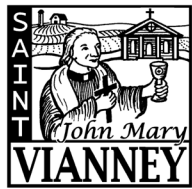

3. Keep non-perishable snacks or gift meal cards handy to give to those in need on the streets.



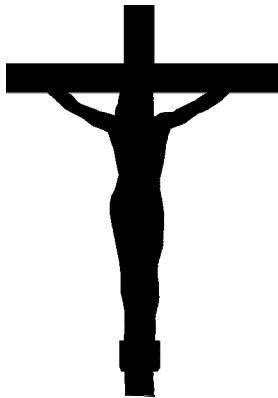

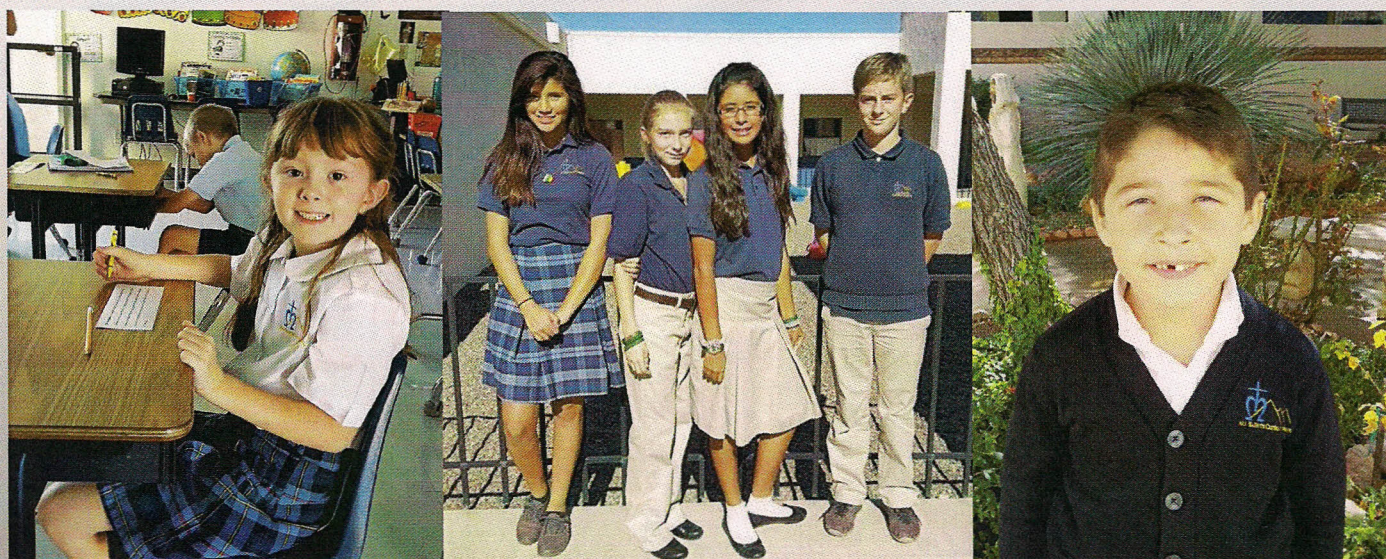
