Ayman Khair representing about 140 Christian families from Bethlehem will be here. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East, the tourism has been cut off. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles** are beyond **description**. Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. 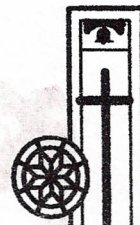
