

The 2016 theme for the Catholic School Collection is "Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge and Service." The logo that was designed by the National Catholic Educational Association for Catholic Schools' Week 2017, and which will be used for our Collection, features a swirl of colors interacting around a cross - the center of all Catholic education.
