



DATES TO REMEMBER

Sunday, October 30 All Saint's Celebration


October 18 is the feast of St. Luke, the Evangelist. Luke wrote a major portion of the New Testament, a two volume work comprising the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. In the two books, he shows the parallel between the life of Christ and that of the Church. He is the only Gentile Christian among the Gospel writers. Tradition holds him to be a native of Antioch, and Paul calls him "the beloved physician" (Colossians 4:14). His gospel was probably written between A.D. 70 and 85.

Luke appears in Acts during Paul's second journey, remains at Phillippi for several years until Paul returns from his third journey. He then accompanies Paul to Jerusalem and remains near him when he is imprisoned in Caesarea. During these two years, Luke had time to seek information and interview persons who had known Jesus. He accompanied Paul on the dangerous journey to Rome where he was a faithful companion. "Luke is the only one with me," Paul writes in 2 Timothy 4:11.

Luke wrote as a Gentile for Gentile Christians. His Gospel reveals Luke's expertise in classic Greek style as well as his knowledge of Jewish sources. Luke's Gospel is sometimes called the "Gospel of Universal Salvation." He said Jesus died for all. Jesus is the son of Adam, not just David, and Gentiles are His friends too.




