The Second year Confirmation students have recently begun a study of the Mass. This study is meant to help them understand what the Mass really is and why we do what we do. It is to be hoped that at the end of the study the teens will have begun to appreciate the Mass and the great gift that it is. Some of what they are studying may be helpful to those of us long past Confirmation.

The first lesson asks the students to reflect on the five most important things in their life. They must list these five things. Then they are asked to list the five things that take up the most time in their lives. One of the interesting discoveries here was almost to be expected. Most of the students listed God as the number one most important thing in their lives. Yet under the five things that take up the most time in my life God ranks down there at 4 or 5. Less time than sports or video gaming. Students at this age tend to be quite literal. God takes up very little time because they devote ten minutes a day to prayer.

How about us as adults? If God is most important in our lives how much time a day do we devote to him? Have we learned to incorporate God into all we do? St. Paul tells us to pray always. None of us can or would want to spend 24/7 kneeling in Church but do we remember our morning offering every day? Do we maybe stop for a second every hour and offer up the next hour of work as a prayer for someone or something? When we are faced with the beauty and wonders of God all around do we take a moment to thank and praise God for this moment in time? Are you satisfied that you give God as much time as he is due or could you perhaps improve?
