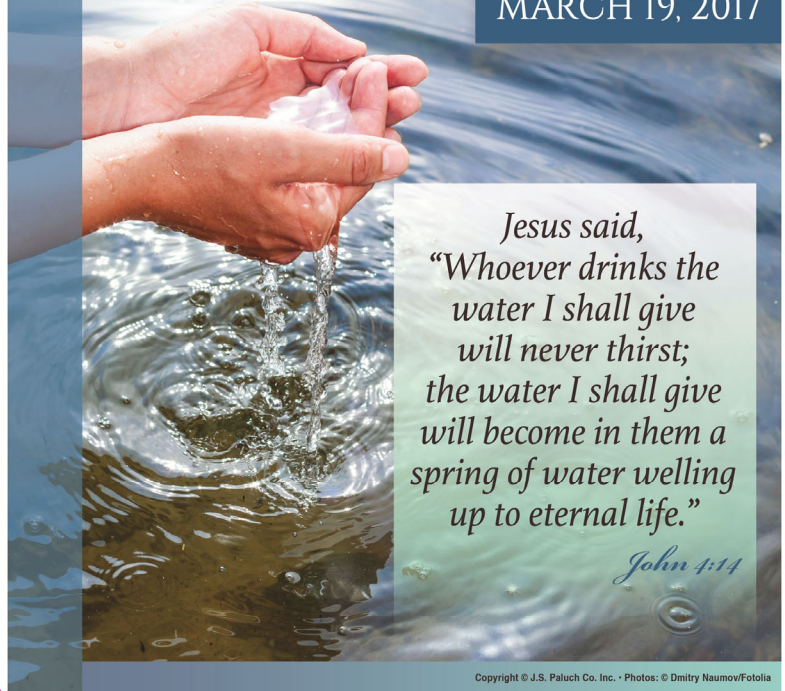

- ¿Quién, de entre mis prójimos tiene sed? ¿Cómo les puedo dar de beber?

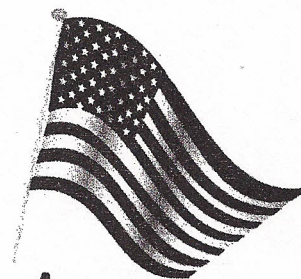


Help Change Lives
