





## A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

#### Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

#### A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,250 Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,067

Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$183

#### A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your AZ tax withholding: \$1,500
Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): -\$1,250
Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid): \$250
Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,067

Your new AZ tax refund increases to: \$1,317

Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. Taxpayers may not claim a tax credit if the taxpayer agrees to swap donations with another taxpayer to benefit either taxpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for quidance.

## Q. What if I don't yet know if I have any Arizona Tax liability for 2016?

### A. To get an idea, check your 2015 taxes.

If you have ANY dollar amount on this line, you could have made a tax-credit gift at ZERO-COST to you.
