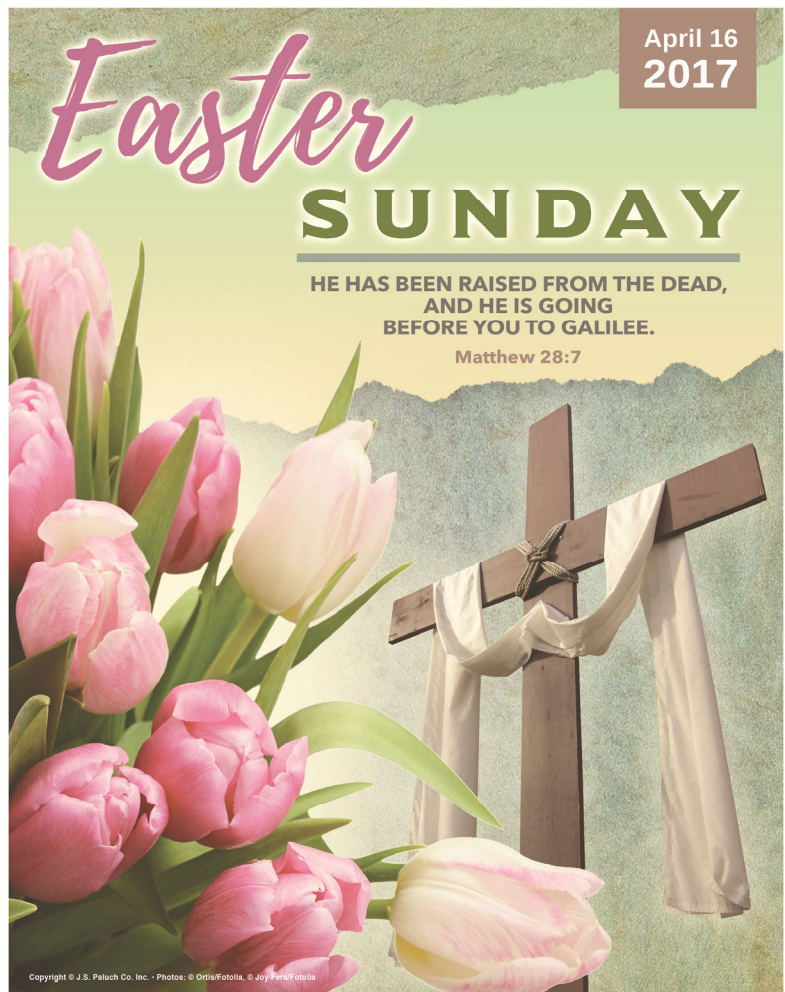

## This is The day The Lord Has Made

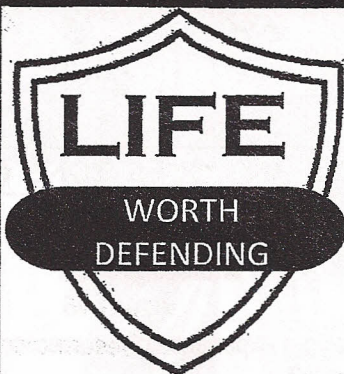
Jesus rose from the dead "on the first day of the week." ...For Christians it has become the first of all days, the first of all feasts, the Lord's Day. (ccc 2174).
