Following this she showed the children a vision of hell. 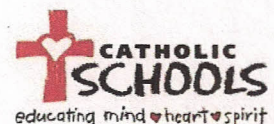

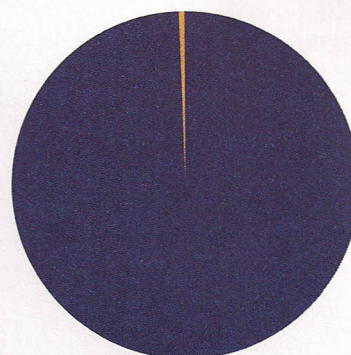

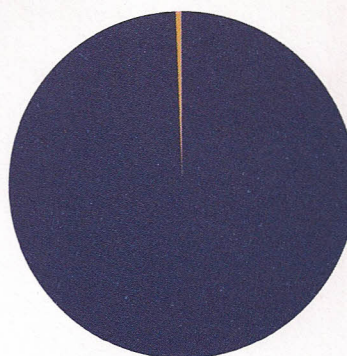
