



St. Padre Pio called the Rosary a weapon for these modern times. It is, perhaps, fitting then, that so often when Mary has left her throne and come back to us, she comes wielding her Rosary, imploring us to pray it every day. This was one of her central messages at Fatima.

The Rosary is often misunderstood as worshipping Mary. But in fact it is a Biblical prayer that draws us closer to Christ and teaches us about his life. The Rosary prayers consist of the Apostles' Creed, confirming belief in our faith; the Glory Be, praising the Holy Trinity; the Our Father, given to us by Christ Himself; and the Hail Mary, its words coming primarily from the greetings to Mary by the Archangel Gabriel and by Mary's kinswoman, Elizabeth, as recorded in Scripture (Lk 1:28,42). Additionally, as we pray, we are encouraged to meditate on the mysteries of Jesus and Mary's lives in Scripture.
