

Today is the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus. Let us reflect on what the early church fathers had to say about the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Jesus.


St. Ignatius of Antioch was a disciple and contemporary of the Apostle John. About 110 A.D. he wrote concerning certain heretics: "They abstain from the Eucharist and from prayer, because they do not confess that the Eucharist is the flesh of our Savior Jesus Christ, flesh which suffered for our sins and which the Father, in His goodness, raised up again."

Again St. Ignatius writes: "I desire the Bread of God, which is the Flesh of Jesus Christ...and for drink I desire His Blood, which is love incorruptible."

St. Cyril of Jerusalem in a catechetical lecture given about 350 A.D. said: "Do not, therefore, regard the bread and wine as simply that; for they are, according to the Master's declaration, the Body and Blood of Christ. Even though the senses suggest to you the other, let faith make you firm. Do not judge in this matter by taste, but be fully assured by the faith, not doubting that you have been deemed worthy of the Body and Blood of Christ."






