



You may have noticed that the header at the top of this column has changed. A name means a great deal. Religious Education is for young people and is often perceived as something the church should do for the children. Faith Formation is life-long. The church, of course, plays a vital role but not an exclusive one. The family forms the cornerstone of our faith formation and supports and encourages our lifelong growth in the faith.

The family is the "domestic church." (Lumen Gentium 11)

When parents bring their children for Baptism it is a joyous time. Often the child is an infant and the whole parenting experience is new and wonderful and perhaps, a bit overwhelming at times. During the Baptism Rite the parents are specifically addressed as follows: "You are accepting the responsibility of training (this child) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring (this child) up to keep God's commandments..." The parents agree but sometimes the awesome responsibility is lost in worry about the child screaming or will the in laws get along at dinner or the older child breaking loose from grandma and running lose in church. Nevertheless, all Catholic parents have been entrusted with this child of God and given the task of teaching the child how to practice the faith and live one day with God in heaven.

Therefore, truly, it is necessary that the church support the parents in their role as primary educators of their children in the faith. The Catechism of the Catholic Church at number 2223 puts it this way, "parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children."

Family Faith Formation is an attempt to provide support and encouragement to the domestic church....all of them in our parish. Children's classes yes, parent sessions yes, and shared activities also. The hope is the entire family will grow together in love for the Lord. Our Faith Formation year will begin on August 20 with a family activity. Beginning at 1:30 we will share in a barbecue and games afternoon. All families are welcome. Please bring a dish to share. A meal is a great way to become acquainted. The better we know each other the better we can support each other as our domestic church creates and builds our parish family. See you there!

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair that these families have a little income and are able to stay living in the Holy Land.

Amazingly enough, The Christians population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 30 years. Thank you in advance for your support.
