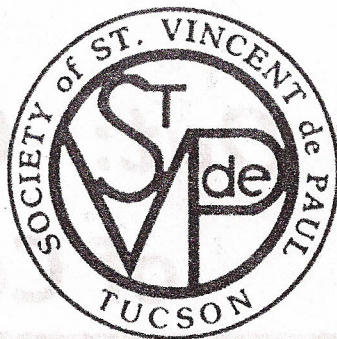
DATES TO REMEMBER

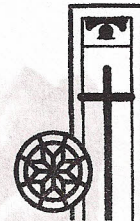

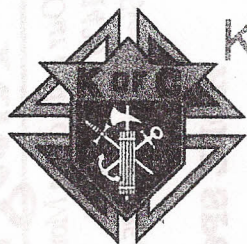
