





Dream Act of 2017

President Donald Trump has given the Congress six months to develop legislation that would be a permanent solution to the status of young people who illegally entered our country as children. They are known as Dreamers and are engaged in their education and involved in using their gifts to enhance our nation and communities.

Currently the Dream Act of 2017 (S.1615/H.R. 3440) has been introduced into the Congress. This Bill offers qualifying youth "conditional permanent resident status" and a path to full lawful permanent residency and eventual citizenship.

I encourage you to write to our Congressional Delegation and express your support for the "Dream Act 2017" and urge our representatives in Congress to support this Bill which will protect immigrant youth who enter the United States as children and know America as their only home.

Make your voice heard.
