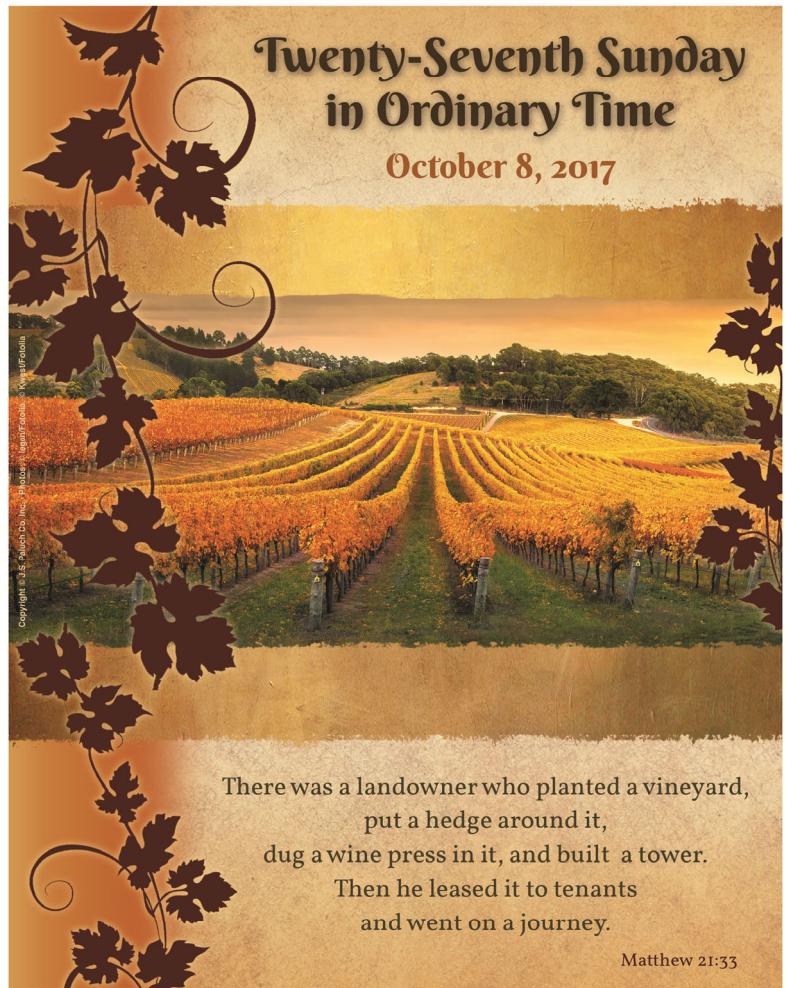

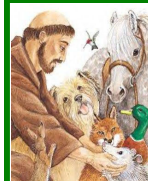

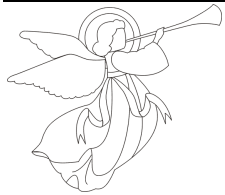
## All Saints Catholic School News

**October 8 we will not have classes because of Fall Break. If you are staying in town remember the Our Lady of Fatima Procession at 2:00 the afternoon of the 8<sup>th</sup>. Bring the children and pray to our Lady as a family. Afterward join in the potluck refreshments in the hall. This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Our Lady's appearance to the children in Fatima. Share the story with the children before you come. It's a great one!**

Yes, it is October! Halloween is coming! Did you know that Halloween is Christian in origin and even rather American? Halloween falls on October 31 because of a pope, and its observances are a result of medieval Catholic piety. There has long been a belief linking Halloween to a Celtic Druid celebration. It is true that ancient Celts of Ireland and Britain celebrated a minor festival on October 31 but they did this on the last day of most of the months of the year. Halloween, however, falls on October 31 because the Feast of All Saints, or All Hallows (means holy as in "hallowed be your name") falls on November 1. The feast to honor all the saints in heaven used to be celebrated on May 13, but Pope Gregory III (d.741) moved it to November 1, the dedication day of All Saints Chapel in St. Peter's in Rome. Later, in the 840's, Pope Gregory IV commanded that All Saints be observed everywhere. So the feast spread to Ireland. The day before the feast was the feast's vigil, "All Hallows' Eve," or "Hallowe'en". In those days Halloween didn't have any special significance for Christians or for long dead Celtic pagans.

In 998, St. Odilo, the abbot of the powerful monastery of Cluny in southern France, added a celebration on November 2. This was a day of prayer for the souls of all the faithful departed. It became known as "All Soul's Day" and spread from France to the rest of Europe. To be continued....
