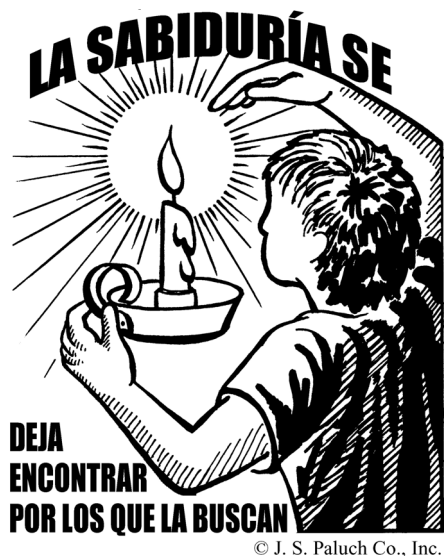

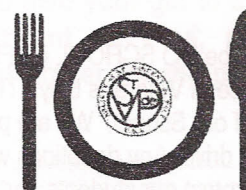
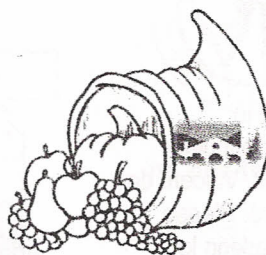
Come For Advent Light

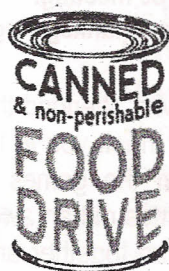
22nd Annual Thanksgiving Dinner Boxes Food Drive
