All Saints Catholic School donated 39 turkeys and 300lbs. of canned goods, Zumba Classes donated 16 turkeys in memory of Rita Pender and Maria Waldman, the Wild Turkey Federation also donated 53 turkeys. Many hands helped to accept, sort, and display the feast. We thank the many hands that help load and unload donations, especially the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade religion class and the K of C helpers and wives. You may wonder, is a Thanksgiving food box necessary; here is one example of how important the boxes and this church are to those who come to us.

A man, who has a portable oxygen tank, rode his bike to our office from Moson Road, to register for a food box. As a young man he helped construct our cross and bell tower. What happiness he has to remember better times and knowledge that his family will be blessed once more with your generosity. Thanks, to all who came together to make this Thanksgiving special for our friends.

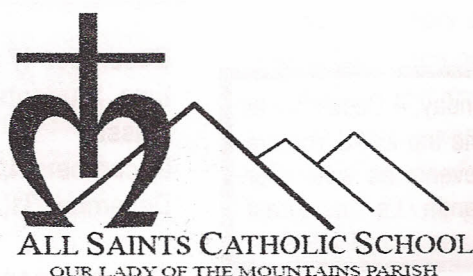
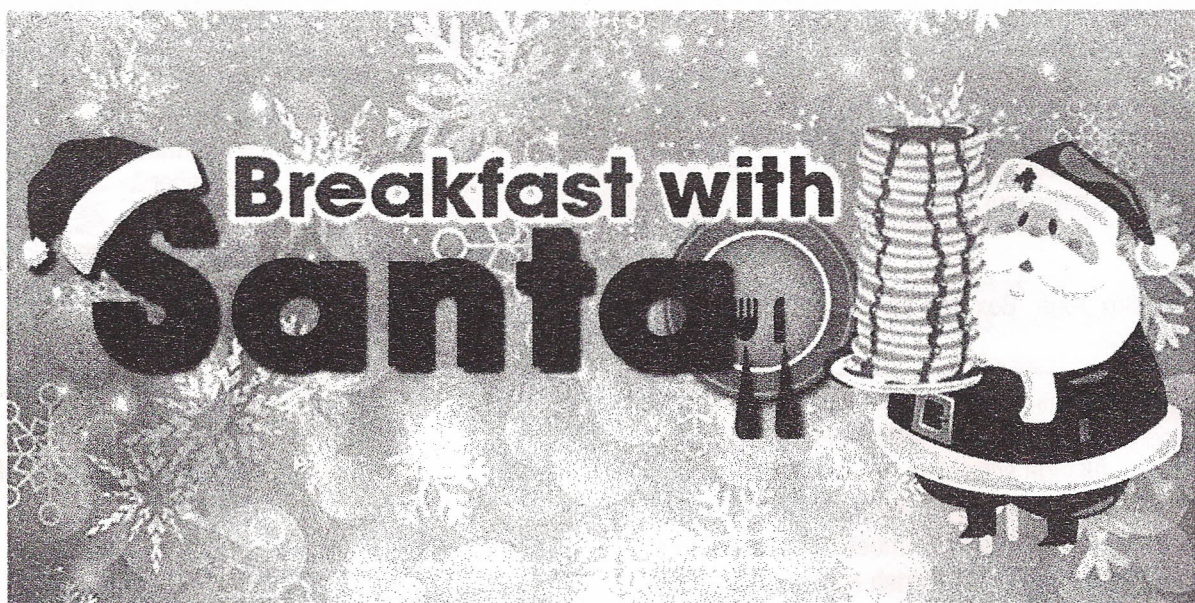
**Friday, December 8,** Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Holy Day of Obligation

A feast called the Conception of Mary arose in the Eastern Church in the seventh century. It came to the West in the eighth century. In the eleventh century it received its present name, The Immaculate Conception. In the eighteenth century it became a feast of the universal church.

In 1854 Pius IX solemnly proclaimed: " The most Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instant of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin."

It took a long time for this doctrine to develop. While many fathers and doctors of the church considered Mary the greatest and holiest of the saints, they often had difficulty seeing Mary as sinless; either at her conception or throughout her life. This is one of the church teachings that arose more from the piety of the faithful than from the insights of brilliant theologians. Two Franciscans, William of Ware and Blessed John Duns Scotus, helped develop the theology. They point out that Mary's Immaculate Conception enhances Jesus' redemptive work. Other members of the human race are cleansed from original sin after birth. In Mary, Jesus' work was so powerful as to prevent original sin at the outset.
