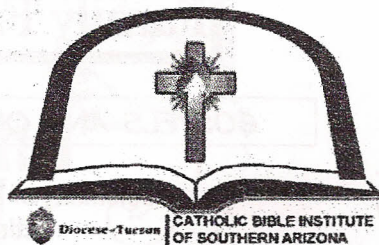
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL REGISTRATION

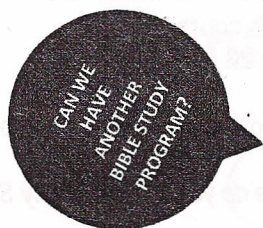
Dear Parents of Religious Education Students Current or Eligible:

Your input is needed!!! We are looking for ways to structure the RE program to better serve our families. The **Catholic Bible Institute of Southern Arizona (CBISA)** is a three-year program that involves a comprehensive study of the Sacred Scriptures, with particular focus on methods of biblical study, sharing and praying with scripture, and application of skills in Bible-study leadership.

The CBISA Goals are to:

Grow in understanding and appreciation of the revealed Word of God ~ **Learn** the basic principles of Catholic interpretation of the Sacred Scriptures ~ **Integrate** Bible study with Christian prayer and daily living ~ **Receive** training for parish-based Bible study leadership.

YEAR I 2018-2019 includes an introduction to the New Testament, with study of the four Gospels, the Acts of the Apostles, Pauline Letters, Catholic Epistles, Book of Revelation, Non-canonical Writings, and New Testament Theology.

YEAR II 2019-2020 includes an overview of the Hebrew Scriptures, with study of the Pentateuch/Torah, Historical Books, Prophetic Books, Wisdom Literature, Deutero-canonical Writings, and Hebrew Theology.

YEAR III 2020-2021 focuses on developing practical skills for working with small groups, with an emphasis on adult learning, facilitation skills, group process, Bible-study resources, and leadership training.
