

The **Catholic Bible Institute of Southern Arizona (CBISA)** is a three-year program that involves a comprehensive study of the Sacred Scriptures, with particular focus on methods of biblical study, sharing and praying with scripture, and application of skills in Bible-study leadership.

The CBISA Goals are to:

Grow in understanding and appreciation of the revealed Word of God ~ Learn the basic principles of Catholic interpretation of the Sacred Scriptures ~ Integrate Bible study with Christian prayer and daily living ~ Receive training for parish-based Bible study leadership.
