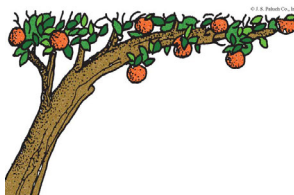

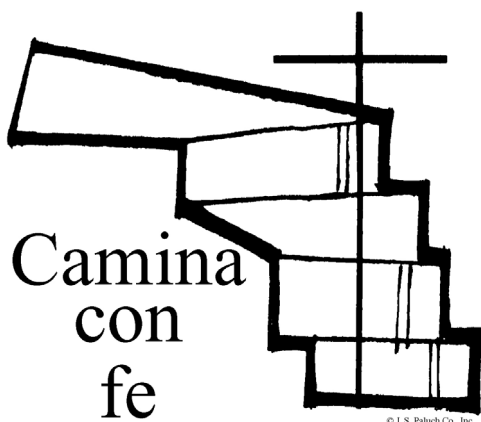
### Marriage Tip of the Week

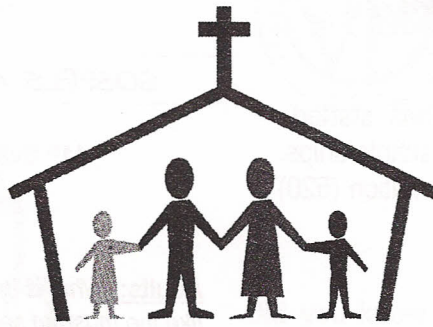
