


Marriage Tip of the Week

<u>Adults</u>: When has the bread of life given you the strength you needed to face a difficult situation in your life? <u>Children/Youth</u>: What will you ask Jesus to help you with when you receive Holy Communion this week?

Registration for Faith Formation classes for all ages will be held next Sunday, **19 August**, after the 9:30 Mass. We will meet in the hall. There will also be open house so you can meet your child's catechist and view the material for the coming year. There is not fee.

Starting at age 3 through kindergarten classes are held during the 9:30 Mass. The program used is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Classes are held in the atrium (old library). The atrium is like a mini retreat house, a place for prayerful work. The child's work becomes a conversation with God. The program emphasizes quiet contemplation and – imagine this – "the enjoyment of God." The children hear Bible stories and watch them acted out with simple materials, after which they are free to explore the materials of choice. To grow more deeply in love with Jesus, the Good Shepherd, the little ones sing songs, pray and utilize child size materials related to the Mass, liturgical cycles, and parables to help them better understand our faith.




