





Catholic Campaign for Human Development Collection November 17 – 18, 2018

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The annual collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) is scheduled for the weekend of Nov. 17-18 in our Diocese of Tucson. In the USA, over 46 million people (one in 6, one in 5 children) live in poverty, which means they are not able to provide a sustainable existence for their families. CCHD is the United States Catholic Bishops' domestic anti-poverty program. As a result of the generous donations from Catholics throughout the USA, CCHD is able to award grants to dioceses for projects that address root causes of poverty (75%) while 25% of monies collected in each diocese stays in the diocese.

In our own Diocese of Tucson, CCHD grants support interfaith advocacy groups that address issues such as: opposition to payday lending; helping immigrants know their legal rights; voter registration efforts; leadership training for people living in poverty; employment opportunities (JobPath), to name a few issues raised by grassroots citizens. One current CCHD grant application being submitted in Tucson is a local community effort to develop a neighborhood cultural center that will provide employment for local residents.

I commend the faithful of the Diocese of Tucson for your historically generous response to needs, whether they be unexpected crisis situations or annual requests for the ongoing needs of our brothers and sisters. The Catholic Campaign for Human Development provides an opportunity for us to tangibly help folks in poverty who may be our next door neighbors or are the hidden marginalized. Please prayerfully consider how you are able to help us address poverty issues in our diocese and across the United States.

Colecta de la Campaña Católica para el Desarrollo Humano 17-18 de noviembre de 2018

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

La colecta anual de la Campaña Católica para el Desarrollo Humano (CCHD) está programada para el 17-18 de noviembre en nuestra Diócesis de Tucson. En los EUA más de 46 millones de personas (uno de 6, uno de 5 niños) viven en la pobreza, lo que significa que no les es posible proveer una existencia sostenible para sus familias. CCHD es el programa domestico anti-pobreza de los Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos. Como resultado de las donaciones generosas de católicos a través de los Estados Unidos, CCHD ha podido otorgar subsidios a las diócesis para proyectos que abordan las raíces de la pobreza (75%) así como el 25% de las donaciones que se colectan en cada diócesis se quedan en la diócesis.

En nuestra propia Diócesis de Tucson, las subvenciones de CCHD apoyan a grupos interreligiosos que abordan los asuntos tal como la oposición a los préstamos de día de pago, ayudan a inmigrantes para que tengan conocimiento de sus derechos legales, para los esfuerzos de registro de votantes, capacitación de liderazgo para las personas que viven en la pobreza, oportunidades de trabajo (JobPath), para nombrar solo algunos asuntos planteados por ciudadanos con raíces en la comunidad. Una subvención del CCHD que recién se ha solicitado en Tucson es un esfuerzo local de la comunidad para desarrollar un centro cultural del barrio que proveerá trabajos a los residentes locales.

Felicito a los fieles de la Diócesis de Tucson por su respuesta históricamente generosa a las necesidades, ya sea situaciones de crisis inesperadas o solicitudes anuales para las necesidades continuas de nuestros hermanos y hermanas. La Campaña Católica para el Desarrollo Humano nos da la oportunidad de ayudar, de una forma tangible, a gente en la pobreza que pudieran ser nuestros vecinos o los marginados. Por favor, en oración, piensen como pueden ayudarnos enfrentar los problemas de la pobreza en nuestra diócesis y a través de los Estados Unidos.
