


Have you ever wondered why the priest says what he says or does what he does during Mass?

Monetary contributions are also fine—please make out checks to St. Vincent de Paul.



Online Giving Transition



Dear Parish Family & Friends,

Just a reminder that the old online giving website will close at the end of November. Please follow the instructions below and suspend your online giving on the old site and set up your online giving on the new site.

Here are the instructions for a smooth transition...

1. Go to the old site and suspend your giving-

Website: <https://www.myowngiving.com/Default.aspx?cid=1144>

- Click on "My Active Online Giving" View/Edit Gifts that you are "*actively giving*" to.
- Click on each gift, go to gift status and click on the bubble to suspend gift.
- Click on Submit to apply changes.
- On the My Online Giving page the status should show "**SUSPENDED**" in red.

2. Go to the new site and register your account

Left sidebar:

- ❖ "First Time" >>New User Registration to register, and complete form.
- ❖ "Scheduled Giving" >>Automatic Recurring Donations: Choose from the drop down list of funds for your recurring donations. You can choose to make them weekly, monthly, etc.
- ❖ How to donate: "use check" image top right of your screen to set up banking information [smaller fees for this method of donating] or choose one of the following options; debit card, check card or Visa/MasterCard.
- ❖ "My Account" Personal Info & History: Review or edit for accuracy.

Anyone wanting to begin Online Giving, simply follow step 2. Quarterly envelopes will be discontinued when giving online.

"I Gave Online" Cards are in the back of church for you to place in the collection basket.
