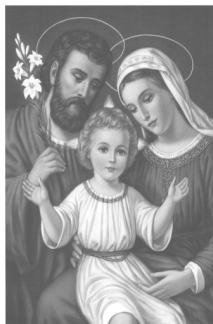

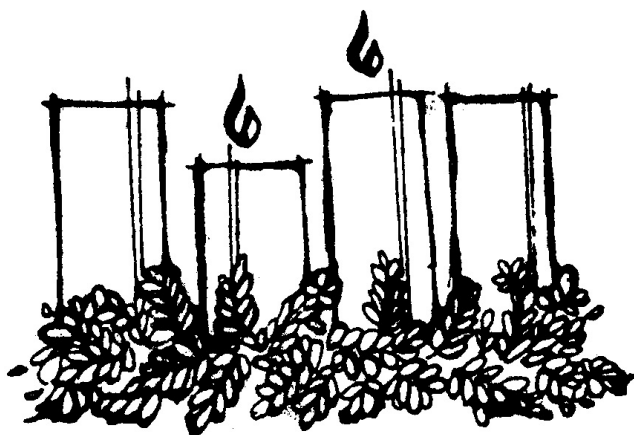

Did You Know?

Medieval mystery plays employed fir trees decorated with apples to symbolize the Garden of Eden with its tree of life and forbidden fruit. Long after the mystery plays, the Germans remembered the tree, modifying its decoration by adding sacramental wafers along with the apples, to contrast the eating that brought death with the eating that brings life. As the decorations became more elaborate, the symbolism of the fall and redemption faded. Apples were joined by oranges and then brightly colored balls, while wafers became cookies cut in the shape of angels, stars, animals, and flowers.



What is the origin of the Advent Wreath?

The origin dates to pre-Christian Germany & Scandinavia where the people gathered to celebrate the return of the sun after the winter solstice. For us, the lighting of the Advent candles represents the promise of the coming of Jesus, the light of the world.
