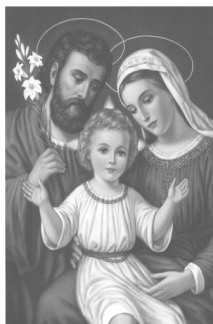

Our Lady of the Mountains (OLM) Knights of Columbus Council 10799 has established an **Educational Scholarship/Grant Program** aimed at providing financial assistance to high school seniors, or students in college, that are pursuing higher education and who are members of OLM Parish or Holy Family Catholic Community.

Our Council has awarded scholarships for the last 20 years or so. We start the process in January by announcing that the scholarships will be awarded with a presentation to the selected applicants in May.

The applicants must submit an Application Packet that includes selection criteria, application details (such as goals, accomplishments, grades), and compose an essay from topics included in the application packet.

The submitted applications are evaluated by a panel from volunteer members of the council. The evaluation follows a detailed process that ensures a fair evaluation of applicants that have applied for the scholarships.

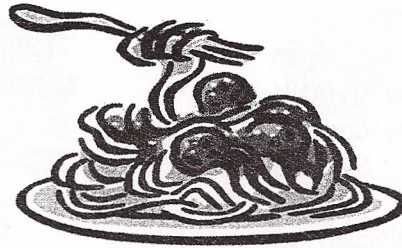
