



# DATES TO REMEMBER

March 17, 18 – No class Spring Break March 24,25 - Class resumes March 23- 10:00 am Celebration of First Reconciliation Happy Lent!!

The key to understanding the meaning of Lent is Baptism. Preparation for Baptism and for renewing baptismal commitment lies at the heart of the season. Since Vatican II, the Church has reemphasized the baptismal character of Lent.

Why is Baptism so important to understanding Lent? Lent as a forty day season developed in the fourth century. There were 3 sources that came together at that time to make the forty days of Lent that we now know. First was the ancient paschal fast that began as a two day observance before Easter but was lengthened to forty days over time. The second was the catechumate (RCIA) as preparation for Baptism which included an intense period of preparation for the sacraments of initiation to be celebrated at Easter. The third was the Order of Penitents, which sought a second conversion for those who had fallen back into serious sin after Baptism and was modeled after the catechumenate. As the catechumens (those preparing for Baptism) entered their final period of preparation the penitents and the rest of the community accompanied them on their journey and prepared to renew their Baptismal vows at Easter. So then Lent is baptismal in its nature. How well are you living out your baptismal vocation as priest, prophet, king? How could vou grow in your spiritual life this Lent?

\*Arizona now allows contributions up to \$2,213 for a couple filing jointly and \$1,107 for an individual as long as it doesn't exceed your tax liability. Contributions made in 2018 and up to April 15, 2019 may qualify for tax credits on your 2018 Arizona state return.

# A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

- Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?
- A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability. Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,250 Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$161

# A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your new AZ tax refund increases to:	\$1,339
Your tax credit to CTSO:	-\$1,089
Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid):	\$250
Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill):	-\$1,250
Your AZ tax withholding:	\$1,500

Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. Taxpayers may not claim a tax credit if the taxpayer agrees to swap donations with another taxpayer to benefit either taxpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for quidance.


