

**Happy Lent!!**

The key to understanding the meaning of Lent is Baptism. Preparation for Baptism and for renewing baptismal commitment lies at the heart of the season. Since Vatican II, the Church has reemphasized the baptismal character of Lent.

Why is Baptism so important to understanding Lent? Lent as a forty day season developed in the fourth century. There were 3 sources that came together at that time to make the forty days of Lent that we now know. First was the ancient paschal fast that began as a two day observance before Easter but was lengthened to forty days over time. The second was the catechumate (RCIA) as preparation for Baptism which included an intense period of preparation for the sacraments of initiation to be celebrated at Easter. The third was the Order of Penitents, which sought a second conversion for those who had fallen back into serious sin after Baptism and was modeled after the catechuminate. As the catechumens (those preparing for Baptism) entered their final period of preparation the penitents and the rest of the community accompanied them on their journey and prepared to renew their Baptismal vows at Easter. So then Lent is baptismal in its nature. How well are you living out your baptismal vocation as priest, prophet, king? How could you grow in your spiritual life this Lent?

Sign up for the Outdoor Stations of the Cross on Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm will be in the back of church starting next weekend. This is a wonderful opportunity for families to be involved for Good Friday.

## CARDIOVASCULAR SCREENINGS

### HEART ULTRASOUND

# A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

## Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

### A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,250

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

**Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$161**

### A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your AZ tax withholding: \$1,500

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): -\$1,250

Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid): \$250

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,089

**Your new AZ tax refund increases to: \$1,339**

*Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,250 of AZ tax liability.*

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. Taxpayers may not claim a tax credit if the taxpayer agrees to swap donations with another taxpayer to benefit either taxpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for guidance.

## Q. What if I don't yet know if I have any Arizona Tax liability for 2017?

### A. To get an idea, check your 2017 taxes.

If you filed:	Look at line:
AZ140	Line 46 ("subtotal of tax")
AZ140A	Line 21 ("amount of tax")
AZ140EZ	Line 9 ("amount of tax")
AZ 140PY	Line 58 ("subtotal of tax")


