



Love and Betrayal

April 14

Our fasting during Lent should be linked to our concern for those who are forced to fast by their poverty, those who suffer from the injustices of our economic or political structures, those who are in need for any reason. This way fasting is linked to living out our baptismal promises. Our Baptism bestows on us the responsibility of showing Christ's love to the world, especially those in need. Fasting can help us realize the suffering that so many people in the world experience every day. Fasting should spur us on to greater efforts to help alleviate that suffering.

Abstaining from meat also links us to the poor who often cannot afford meat for their meals. We must embrace abstinence as a spiritual link to those whose diets are sparse and simple from necessity. We should have a sparse and simple meal on the days we abstain from meat. Avoiding meat but having a lobster feast misses the whole point.
