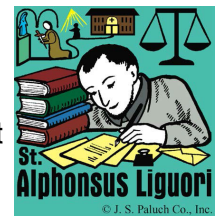

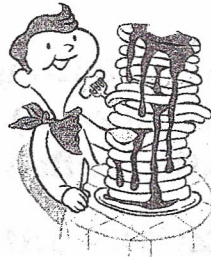

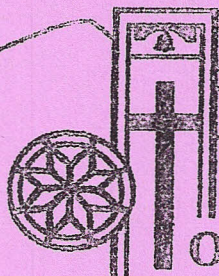

Religious Education Registration is Today July 28

Dear Parents and Parishioners,

It is hard to believe that summer vacation is already ending. Our students will be returning to school this week. It follows then that Religious Education classes will also be resuming. We will start on Sunday, August 18 at 8:00a.m. and Confirmation classes beginning on Monday evening at 7:00p.m. August 19.

As you are aware, there will be a change in time on Sunday mornings. We will have class from 8:00 am to 9:15 am. This change was initiated by several conversations with parents who were concerned that our late start meant that the students were not released until noon. This meant that any family activities were limited and many wished Sunday to be a family day. The other difficulty with the later hours was that classes conflicted with the 11:30 Mass for those who wished to attend that Mass as a family. I am hoping that the time change will address these concerns. If you have any comments or suggestions please feel free to let me know.

There are two other concerns I would like to address. The first is that we are still in need of three catechists. One for grade two, one for grade 4 and one for a combined class of 7and 8 grades. I realize it is a big commitment of time. You do not need a theology degree. You do need a love for our Lord Jesus and the desire to share that love with our children. Materials are provided to guide you in your instruction but the most important part is what is in your heart. We can take care of any concerns you have and you may be surprised at how much you will learn.

My other concern is our youth group program for grades 9 to 12. Are there students who would like to see the program revived in some form? Are there parents who are willing to help with such a program? OLM is a small parish relatively but large enough to provide for our young people. Perhaps a good first step would be to meet and gauge the interest and gather ideas. Call me or fill out the form at registration.

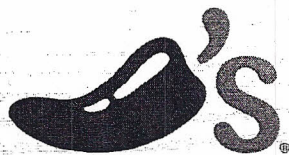
May I add that you do not need to have children in the program to volunteer. All are welcome!

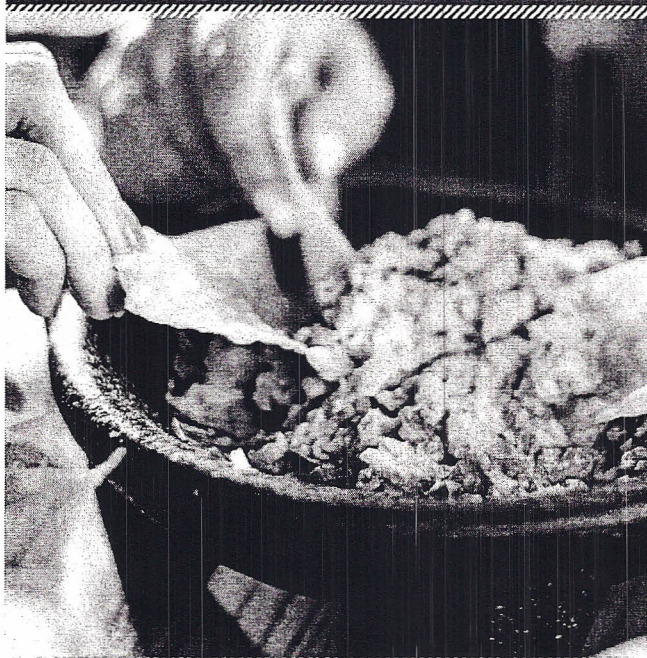

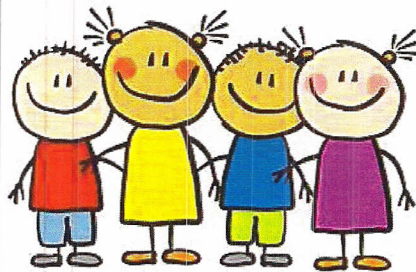

Did you know that every year hundreds of children in Southeast Arizona are placed in foster care? If they are able to bring personal belongings, they may have to carry them in a garbage bag. 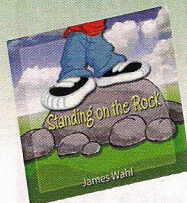

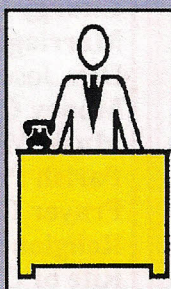

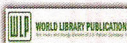
