Ayman Khair will be here representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. Due to the conflict in the Middle East, the tourism has been cut off. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles. Amazingly enough, the Christian population has dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 30 years. These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair that these families have a little income and are able to stay living in the Holy Land. Thank you for your continued support.



May God bless all our students and catechists as we begin this new year growing in our faith.


