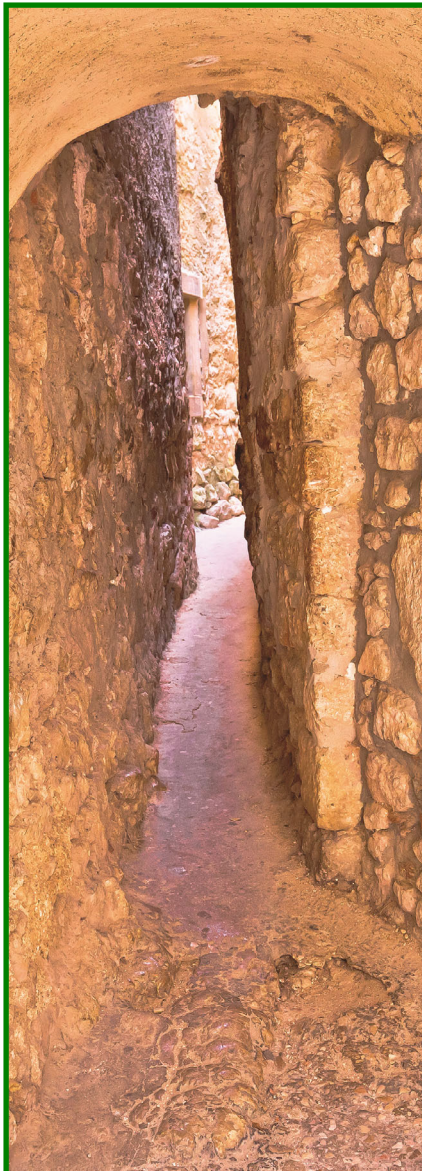

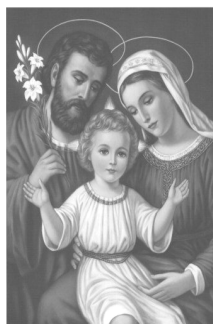

The Men's Conference: Nov. 2, 2019

This year's conference will take place at the diocesan Conference and Educational Building next to St. Augustine Cathedral in downtown Tucson with the theme, "Strength in Numbers."

This year's speakers are Redemptorist Father Dennis Billy, speaking on "Living and Dying in Christ – Our Growing Band of Brothers," and Catholic therapist Randy Cirner, speaking on "Keep Paddling."

The men's conference previously was held at parishes and conference centers in Tucson but is using the diocesan conference center for the first time. The Cathedral Square center is located at 192 S. Stone Ave.

Diocesan Pastoral Services Assistant Director Joe Perdreaux urged men interested in attending to register online early, because attendance will be limited to the first 400 registered.

Registration is available online at tucsonmensconference.org, and walk-ins will be accepted if space permits. Cost is \$45 for adults, \$25 for college students and \$10 for young men 18 or younger.
