The Statue of Our Lady Of Fatima will be the home of Delores Martins until September 15th.

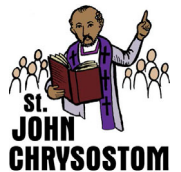

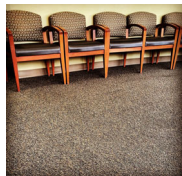

Are You Called to Carmel?

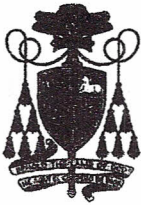
